

Here are the distances RTR's founder Phil came up with to help you draw the first six train tracks, starting from the end of a 5-inch vertical line:

1. 1 inch from the end of the vertical line to first line
2. $\frac{8}{10}$ of an inch from first line to 2nd line
3. $\frac{2}{3}$ of an inch from 2nd to 3rd line
4. $\frac{1}{2}$ of an inch from 3rd to 4th line
5. $\frac{4}{10}$ of an inch from 4th to 5th line
6. $\frac{1}{3}$ of an inch from 5th to 6th line

After the 6th line, draw the rest of the train tracks by sight.

If you want to measure out more lines after the 6th railroad tie, then each successive distance between lines is 20% less than the previous distance.
